Our member-organization of the Dutch NPB and her Dutch sister-organization ACP in cooperation with the Dutch National Police-force have taken the initiative for an action of helping our police-colleagues and their families in Ukraine. Koen Simmers who is a member of our General Assembly is himself going to Poland to deliver the goods!

This subject was discussed this morning in the meeting of the board of EU.Pol.

Unanimous it was decided to bring this initiative under the attention of the members of EU.Pol with the request to organize similar actions with your unions in cooperation with the police-forces in your countries.

The Dutch unions have activated their members to ask them for sending money, aid and safety goods to central addresses in the Netherland.

Off course they will only send protective goods and no firearms or other materials to fight in war.

The intention is to offer the colleagues in Ukraine humanitarian help, security- and medical goods, clothes, and other products.

Please ask the writing and filming press in your countries to give large coverage that police-officers are helping police-officers, because police-officers in Europe are standing for the protection of democracy! You can always send pics or movies to info@eu-pol.eu.

For practical reasons we ask our members to do a financial contribution. This without any obligation. EU.Pol itself will also contribute an amount to our possibilities.
